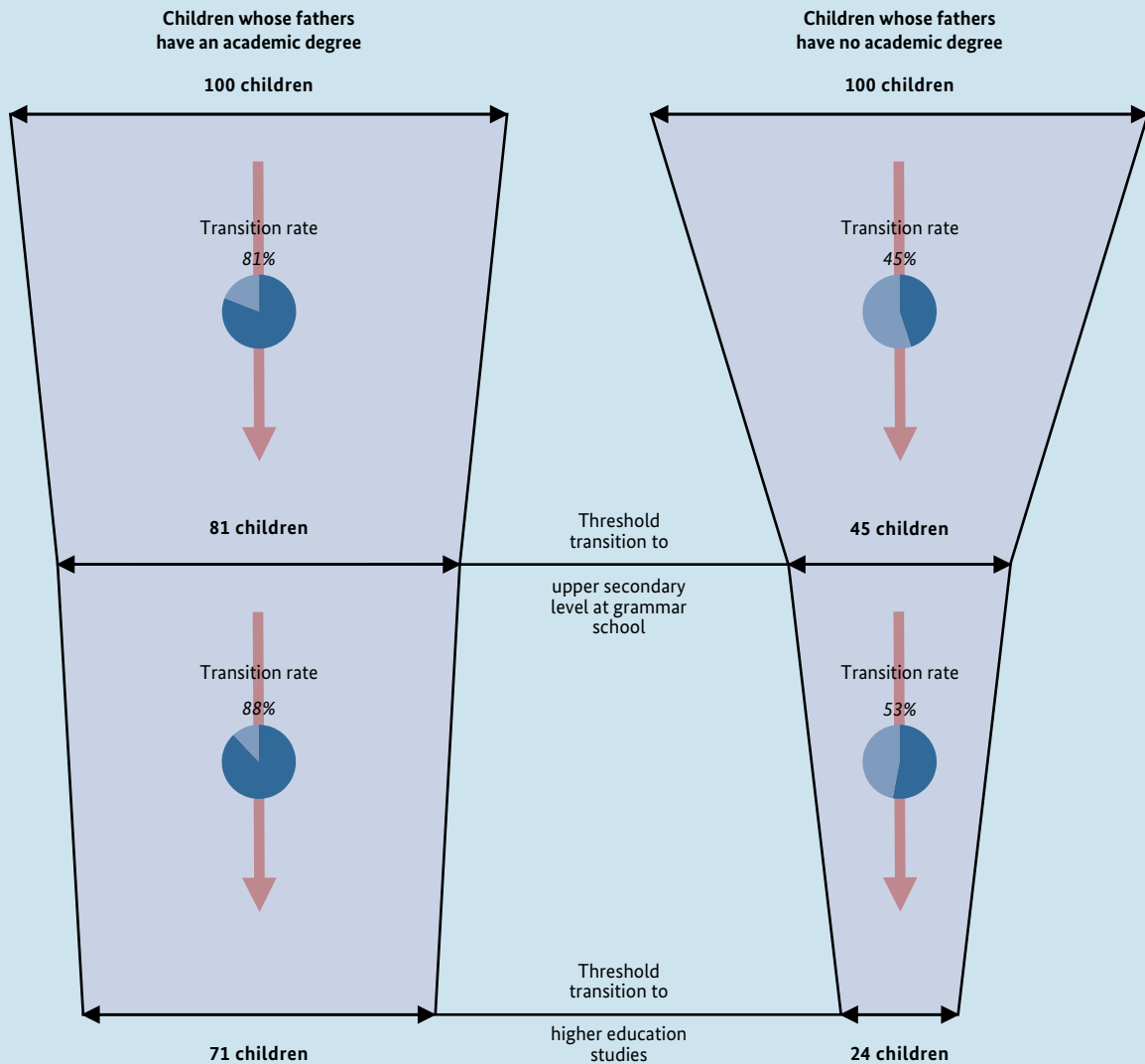


Chart 2.3.35 Educational filter: Social selection and educational paths, by the father's academic degree¹ (2007)

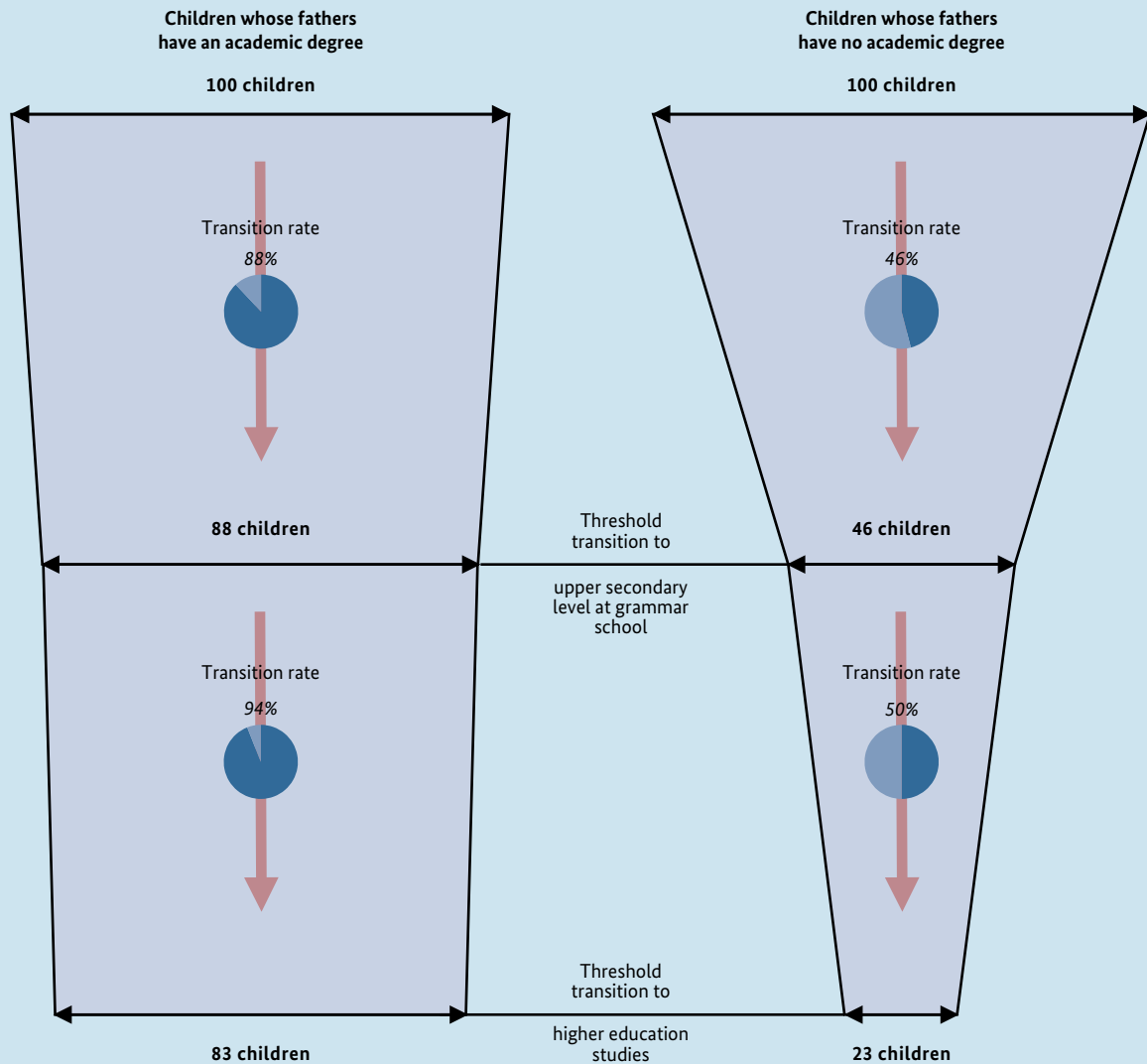

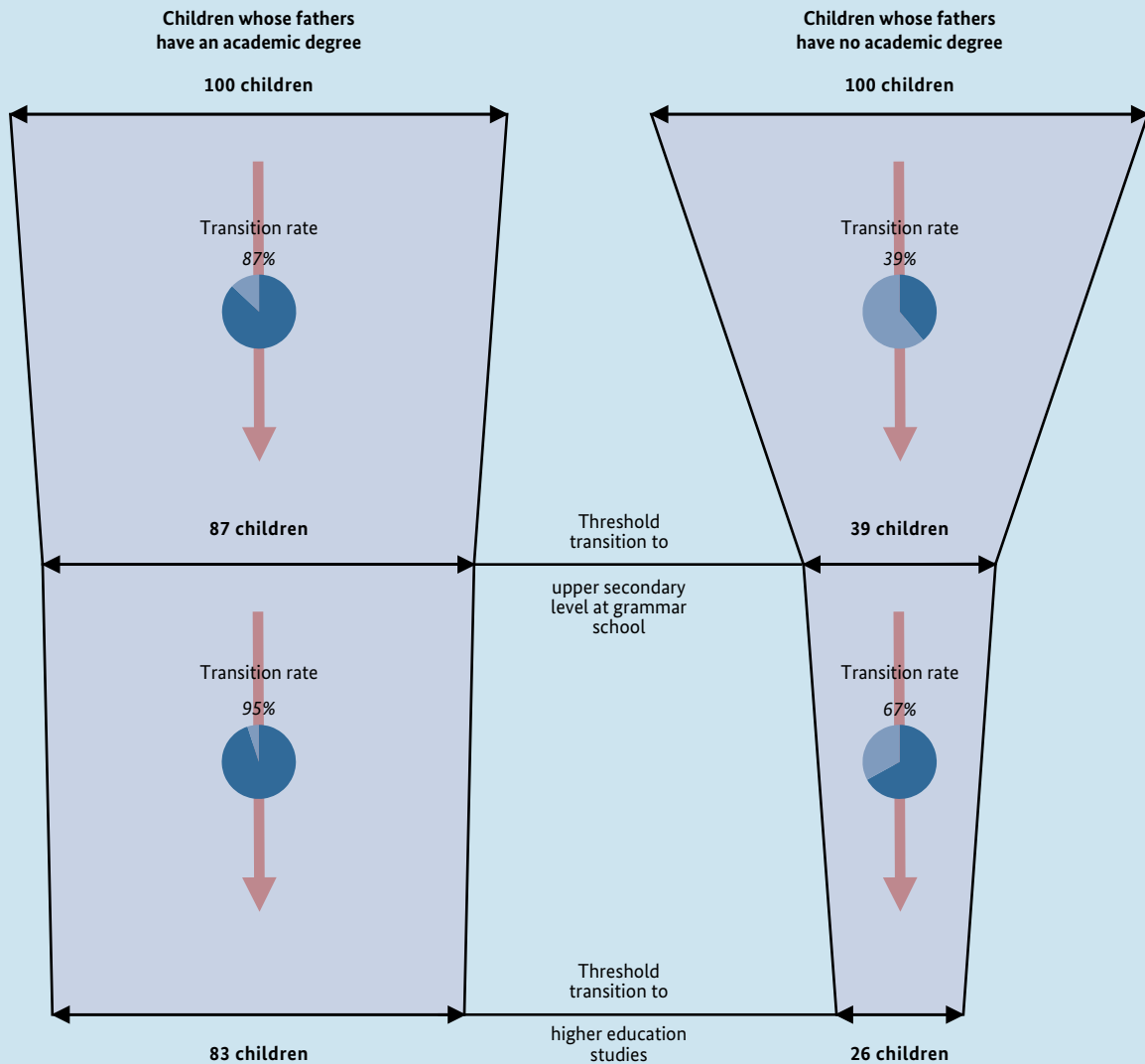
